THE GAMING (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2023

First Schedule
1. These Regulations may be cited as the Gaming (Amendment) Regulations, 2023, and shall be read as one with the Gaming Regulations, 2003, hereinafter referred to as the “principal Regulations”.
  2. These Regulations shall come into operation on 1<sup>st</sup> July, 2023.
  3. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 67B by deleting sub regulation (3) and substituting for it the following:

“(3) The holder of forty machine site licence shall be authorized to place and operate slot machines and not more than two table games in the approved premises.”
  4. The principal Regulations are amended in the First Schedule-
    - (a) by deleting item 32;
    - (b) in item 4, by deleting the figures “10,000” appearing in the fifth column and substituting for them the figures “30,000”;
    - (c) by renumbering item 33, 34, 35, 36, 37, 38, 39, 40, 41 and 42 as item 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 37, 38, 39, 40 and 41 respectively; and
    - (d) adding immediately after item 41 as amended the following new items:
